

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2018-2019  
TENTATIVE BUDGET OF THE VILLAGE OF QUOGUE, 7 VILLAGE LANE, QUOGUE,  
NEW YORK, HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 3, 2018 AT 10:00 A.M.

The Mayor invited everyone to join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon motion made by Kimberley Payne, seconded by Randy Cardo and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, an expenditure of \$7,500 from T37 Parks for hydroseeding of the Village Green by Nassau-Suffolk Landscaping is approved.

Upon motion made by Randy Cardo, seconded by Kimberley Payne and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, an expenditure of up to \$20,000 from T37 for work relating to trenching, landscape lighting and sprinklers is approved.

Upon motion made by Kimberley Payne, seconded by Randy Cardo and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, an expenditure of \$4,283.58 to Spaces Landscape Architecture from T37 Parks for Village Green landscape lights is approved.

Upon motion made by Randy Cardo, seconded by Kimberley Payne and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, an expenditure of \$32,000 to Pershing LLC. from A9089 Fire Service Award, which represents the amount necessary to pay post-entitlement age participants who earned service credit during the calendar year 2017 is approved.

Upon motion made by Kimberley Payne, seconded by Randy Cardo and unanimously carried, it was RESOLVED, the following budget transfers are approved:

From A3120130 Police Part Time Services to A3120411 Police Supplies & Uniforms \$5,000

From A3120450 Police Contracts to A3120411a Police Supplies & Uniforms \$2,500

From A3120130a Part Time Services Jail Attendant to A312022 Police Special Equipment \$2,000
