

Dear Quogue residents,

The Village Office is delaying the date for the start of acceptance of 2020 beach sticker applications (normally April 1) to at least May 1<sup>st</sup>. The principal reason is that we do not know what the status of the Village Beach will be in view of the current restrictions on gatherings. Additionally, we are operating in the Village Office with just a single office worker per day and so are not currently in a position to process a large number of applications. Please be patient.

Rental applications may be submitted to the Village Office by mail or electronically, but people should expect that there may be a delay in processing them. The forms are on the Village website ([www.villageofquogueny.gov](http://www.villageofquogueny.gov)). Please read and follow the instructions carefully.

The beach overpasses at the Village Beach and, after tomorrow, March 26th, at the end of Beach Lane are open to pedestrians, but **please be careful because vehicular traffic also uses the same ramps.**

Also, while a lot of people are walking on the beach and elsewhere for exercise, **remember to exercise social distancing.** Do not congregate in packs.
