PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY UNDER §24 OF ARTICLE 2-B OF NYS EXECUTIVE LAW

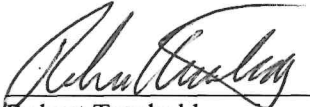
Pursuant to New York State Executive Law §24, a State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Quogue for a period of time beginning at **6:00 a.m.** on the date of September 26, 2026, and continuing in effect for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, unless sooner rescinded or extended.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions anticipated to be produced by the effects of a Nor'easter weather system effecting the Village of Quogue. The National Weather Service has issued warnings and advisories associated with this Nor'easter. Beach and dune erosion is expected to occur as a result of anticipated high surf and wave action. Flooding in low-lying and vulnerable areas is predicted with the forecasted 3 to 5 inches of rainfall and extremely high tides. Sustained winds of 20 to 25 mph with gusts up to 55 mph are expected. Such weather conditions and the possible impacts to coastal portions of our community threaten and/or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the Village of Quogue.

As Mayor of the Village of Quogue, I, Robert Treuhold, have exercised my authority under New York State Executive Law §24, to ensure that all necessary and available assistance from the Village of Quogue may be rendered in furtherance of the health, safety, and well-being of everyone residing and working in our community.

I hereby direct all Quogue Village departments, agencies, and divisions, including, but not limited to, the Fire, Highway, and Police Departments, to take whatever steps necessary to protect life, property, and public infrastructure, and to perform other emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
